



Visitors didn't want to rub my tummy.






I enfered Reedville's fire Cracker 5K, but was disqualified For having too many legs.

Being jobless and almost penniless, I started hanging around the Reedville Market for food, and sifting at the bar with unsavory Characters.








I am currently sailing with my parents to towns without shelfers, passing out flyers on street corners and telling folks there's a waggly tail waiting for them at the shelter.






I hope to rescue more sad and lonely dogs, who were like me."
